She employs 4 Veterinarians and 6 nurses.

She is also an Academic Associate and a member of the faculty of Veterinary Science of the University of Melbourne.

She has been an active supporter of Yudisthira the Bali Street dog Foundation since 2003, assisting with the training for the Balinese Veterinarians and of BAWA (the Bali Animal Welfare association since 2008.

She is also a Board member of the Tsunami Animal People Alliance which runs an ABC- AR program in Sri Lanka, Elaine also runs the volunteer program for TAPA. Elaine assisted as a Veterinary surgeon during the disaster in December 2005 .

This fully trained Sri Lankan team runs a dog and cat desexing and rabies control program along the east coast of Sri Lanka and is the only Veterinary Service (free of charge).

Elaine assists in the management of the VBB's Probono office at Kids on Collins in Melbourne and is on the Veterinary Subcommittee and assists in the screening and placement of volunteers.
